Junior League of Riverside, Inc. New Member Class Obligations: 2009-2010

As a new member of the Junior League of Riverside, Inc., I understand that I must complete the following obligations prior to achieving active membership status.

- Attendance: Attend and participate in a monthly new member class meeting. The Membership Development Chair must be notified in advance if you plan to miss a meeting.
- Attend 5 general meetings of the Junior League of Riverside (or a board meeting in lieu of a general meeting). The general meetings are scheduled for the 3rd Wednesday of each month, excluding July, August, and December.
- Fundraising: Each new member is required to volunteer 4 hours on a designated JLR fundraiser. Current fundraisers are the Charity Ball, Endowment Fund, and Annual Giving Campaign.
- Charity Ball: The 2009 Charity Ball will be held on Saturday, December 5th. Each JLR member is required to purchase 1 **non-transferrable** ticket regardless of attending the ball or not. The price is \$125.00 per ticket.
- Community Service: Each new member is required to volunteer 6 hours on a JLR community project or the new member project.
- Personal: **Each new member must have fun while meeting new people, learning more about the local community and becoming a highly trained volunteer.**
